

5-Year History of Enrollments




5-Year History of Private School Enrollments





5-Year History of Home School Enrollments





Public School Choice Funded in FEFP Fiscal Year 2020-21





5-Year History of District-Governed, FLVS and Lab Schools FTE





5-Year History of Charter School FTE




5-Year Comparison of Percent Change from Prior Year



School Choice Scholarships Funded in FEFP (Through Fiscal Year 2020-21)






2-Year History of Family Empowerment Scholarship Students





5-Year History of Florida Tax Credit Scholarship Students





5-Year History of Florida Tax Credit Scholarship Funding





3-Year History of Hope Scholarship Students




3-Year History of Hope Scholarship Funding




