Legislators just wrapped up the third interim committee week in advance of the 2024 legislative session. So far, things have been quiet. In fact, during the three interim committee weeks, only two education committees have met.

On October 10, the Senate PreK-12 Education Committee received a [presentation on cut scores for FAST](#) and one week later on October 17 the House Education Quality Subcommittee received a [presentation on school safety measures](#).

However, we know that the pace of things will start to pick up soon! The next interim committee week begins on Nov. 6.
